Each home is expected to provide a private bedroom for the Player, and access to kitchen/bathroom/laundry facilities.

**When:** the players for the Lethbridge Bulls arrive in our community, and their Billet Home, during the last two weeks of May and stay for the summer, departing during the first two weeks of August.

**Who:** Billet Homes are mostly comprised of families with children still at home, but retired or childfree couples and/or mature individuals have also joined the Bulls Billet Homes group.
