

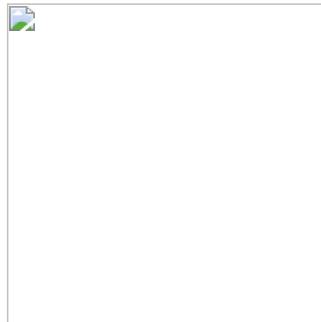

About Roberto Alomar

Roberto "Robbie" Alomar is the definition of a Major League Baseball Icon. He was born in Puerto Rico and raised by his mother Maria alongside his brother Sandy Jr. When Alomar wasn't absorbed in baseball in Puerto Rico, he and his older brother were up in the Majors shagging balls with his father, Santos "Sandy" Alomar, Sr.; who was an All-star second baseman and had a 15 year MLB career.

Like his father, Robbie Alomar was one of the greatest second baseman to play the great game we call baseball. His career began at the young age of 17 with the San Diego Padres where he played alongside his brother, Sandy Jr. an All Star Catcher, and was coached by his father.

In 1991, Alomar was traded to the Toronto Blue Jays with his fellow World Series Champion, Joe Carter. He went on to have a very successful career with Toronto winning a Gold Glove Award and All-star accomplishments each year he was in Toronto (1991-1995), and two-time World Series Championships with Toronto in 1992 and 1993. He went onto win many more awards such as two Silver-Sluggers with his other respected MLB teams.

Alomar was the first ever Blue Jay to be inducted to the Baseball Hall of Fame in 2011 by a vote of 90%. It was very clear how much Alomar meant to the Toronto Blue Jays when they retired his number, #12, in August of 2011.

In March of 2005, Roberto Alomar began to have vision and back troubles. This unfortunately meant he would retire from the game that he loved. After a 17 year MLB career, Alomar recorded .300 Batting Average, 2724 hits, 210 Home Runs, 1,134 RBI's, and 474 Stolen Bases.

Alomar now resides in Toronto with his wife Kim Perks as an advisor to the Toronto Blue Jays. He travels with the Jays Care Organization across Canada to help promote Baseball in Canada and help make sure that every child, no matter their families' income, can play the game that he loved.

The Lethbridge Bulls were an expansion club in the Western Major Baseball League in 1999. Founded by Doug Jones, the Bulls were successful right from the beginning. Jones felt that the Bulls were a perfect fit for Lethbridge, as the PDA was in the city as well.

The team played in the Saskatchewan Major Baseball League for their first three years in existence. Due to the departure of the Lethbridge Black Diamonds, the Bulls now occupied Henderson Stadium as the primary tenant. Attendance for the first three years was very weak and the competition

was limited to three or four Saskatchewan teams.

Current Bulls President/GM Kevin Kvame, who acted as an advisor with Jones since the inception of, became the Bulls 1st GM in 2002. It was at that time, that the Bulls advocated for a much stronger league and wanted expansion into Alberta as a condition of continuing with the league. The league agreed with the Bulls argument and 2002 became the first season for the Western Major Baseball League including the birth of long-time rival Medicine Hat Mavericks.

The 2014 season for the Bulls represents its 16th in the WMBL. During the Bulls tenure in the league, they have won four Western Division titles and advanced to the WMBL Championship Series in 2007 before losing a heartbreaking finale in 2007 to the champion, Swift Current Indians. Last year in 2012, the Bulls fielded the league's Most Valuable Player, 2B/OF Ridge Gonsoulin. Ridge also established a new WMBL single-season consecutive game hitting streak by safely hitting in 25 straight games during the 2012 summer.

The Bulls Baseball Club will forever be tied to the tragedy that occurred in December 2011 when two of its players were tragically killed in Claresholm, Alberta. Tanner Craswell and Mitch MacLean will forever be remembered as Lethbridge Bulls. In 2011, Craswell was a 1st-Team WMBL All-Star, with MacLean taking the Bulls Rookie of the Year Award. Please check out the tab on our menu bar for a section dedicated to these two ballplayers and we ask that you continue to remember these special young men taken far too early from all of those who loved them. The Bulls were proud to retire #13 (Craswell) and #6 (MacLean) prior to the 2012 season and will continue to pay tribute to them annually at the TCMM Memorial Game each May.

The Bulls are excited about our next number of years in the WMBL and look forward to many more successful seasons on the field at Spitz Stadium.

Bulls 2014 Roster Announced

The Lethbridge Bulls are pleased to announce the 2014 Season roster and schedule. The theme of this season is "Making Memories", because some of the best memories start at a ball park! Kevin Kvame, the Bulls President/ General Manager will be presenting the information regarding the schedule and roster with details made by Head Coach Ryan MacDonald will make the roster announcement.

"The Bulls roster has traditionally been finalized between December and February for the most part, but being that we have the majority of it finalized at this point we decided to hope a December Press Conference and update everyone on our news.", commented Bulls GM Kevin Kvame.

The 2014 season is expected to see the Bulls compete for their 5th West Division title and challenge for the WMBL Championship. "We have a great balance of returning players and new contributors which we hope is the right balance to give us the necessary momentum.", said Kvame. "We have a few of the 2014 players with us today and they are excited to give an insight on their 2014 expectations."

Coach MacDonald said this about his team: "In looking over last year's team offensively, I feel we have taken a good base of players who I know can succeed at this level and filled the holes in the line-up last year."

Infielders returning are Evan Comeau (middle infielder) and Mitch Dornblut (first baseman) who are both currently attending University of Arkansas at Monticello. Justin Clarkson and Matt Redfearn (both middle infielders) are among the other returning infielders. Two new comers to the infield are 3B Brady Porter from Red Deer, AB, currently at PBA and is one of the top hitters of the program. The other is Owen Taylor, the 6'2" 200lb of Grand Junction, CO. He is currently in high school but has committed to the University of Kansas in the fall of 2014.

Returning outfielders are Bretton Gouthro (Mount Olive College), Kade Billeaudeau (LSUS) and Taylor Wolstenholme (PBA). Newcomers include Troy Blad, the left-handed hitting freshman at PBA who is fun to watch at the plate. I feel he will help this team hopefully over the next few years. Another exciting new addition to the OF is the Brandon Bufton (LSUS). "Coaches have said the BC native can flat out hit the ball and hit the ball hard." Said Coach MacDonald

Catchers include 3rd year veteran, Travis Steinke (UAM) and Lethbridge American Legion product Trevor Sakatch who is currently attending the Prairie Baseball Academy.

Relief Pitchers returning from the 2013 season are: closer Tyson Hudson (Dixie State), Jake Hansen (LSUS), Chris Stodolka (PBA). Newcomers are right handed relief pitcher Sean Harvie (expected to sign in the next few days) and left handed reliever Austin Cooper. Both of the new relievers are products of the Prairie Baseball Academy. We are very excited about some new starters that we are attending the roster this year; Australian LHP Scott Cone (WTAM) (expecting to sign soon) and RHP Kade Garlington (UAM). "I feel with these two additions will help our starting pitching rotation and will give plenty of options to look for in the pitching roster.", MacDonald says.

In the works, we are still looking for a couple more arms and in contact with a couple of 4-hole guys that will be exciting to watch at the plate and throughout the 2014 season. "

Regarding the 2014 Bulls Schedule we are very excited to have Kirk's Tirecraft to be our official Canada Day 7:35pm game sponsor. We expect to have another exciting crowd on this day and bring the community together to celebrate our nation's birthday. One of the exciting events at the stadium includes our 2nd summer concert featuring local hypnotist, JR Mathew and the extraordinary local cover performers, the Chevelles. This concert has been booked for Saturday, July 12th. We hope to have at least one more concert during the season with August being the targeted period.

We are very excited to announce that our first game of the season will be against Edmonton on May 30th. The home opener will be against Medicine Hat on June 6th. We have three exciting games that are outside of the WMBL Season that include our 3rd Annual

TCMM memorial games that will have the friends/ teammates of Craswell and Mclean as well as the traditional Bulls vs VAB Jets, the Police vs Firefighters Charity Slow pitch game, and the new contribution is the Bulls vs Hurricanes Alzheimer Awareness Game.

The 1st Annual Legends of Sports Gala has been off to an impressive start with more than a third of the tickets already sold. The community is very excited to have the chance to meet Blue Jays legend Roberto Alomar.

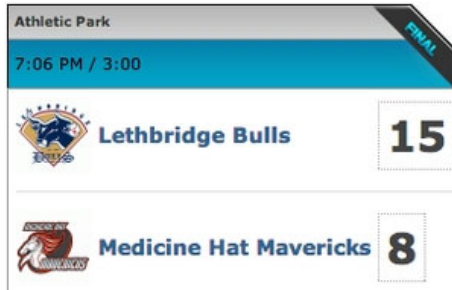

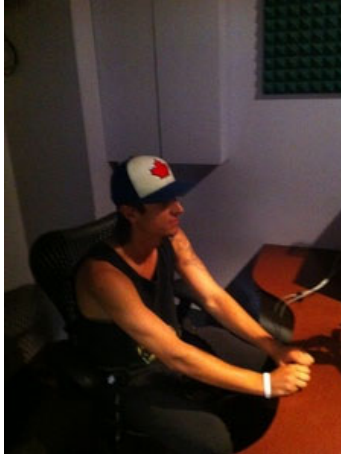
